This year theme - GAME ON! Here are some things to know.

1. Your child must be at their rehearsal in order to be in their performance-please check schedule & mark your calendar.

2. Dancers arrive ready to go onstage 30 minutes before show starts.

3. There is NO livestream available.

4. Ticket sales - Centerstage is NOT selling tickets - make sure you know which shows/shows your child is in so you do not order tickets for the wrong show! Tickets will be available at the door before shows or can be purchased online from Sterling High School <u>centennialauditorium.org</u>

BEFORE Recitals:

- 1. Which show is your dancer in?
- 2. Explain to your dancer that you will to be in the dressing room the whole time but will come back & help them change

& to get them after their last dance to go in & watch the remainder of the show.

- 3. Let them know you will be back to pick them up after they are done dancing and smiling on stage.
- 4. Practice hair & make-up at home.
- 5. Practice costume changes (if any), putting costumes on and off in show order. Take a calm approach, step by step, taking off and dropping pieces into their dance bag.
- 6. No underwear, jewelry or nail polish!
- 7. Pack "Dancer's Survival Kit" (same as rehearsal)
- 8. Pack a book, toy or games. Label all items.
- 9. No Juice or Markers please!

DURING Recitals:

- **2.** Bring dance bag with dancer's name on it.
- 3. Check in at table in hallway by dressing rooms WITH PARENT PICKUP PASS.
- **4.** Come dressed in 1st costume with hair & makeup done. No underwear, jewelry or nail polish.
- 5. Wear cover-ups over costume while traveling. Carry shoes.
- 6. No Juice or Food ! spills and messes make costumes icky!
- 7. We have a few experienced helpers in dressing rooms. They are there to supervise but you are in charge of helping your child change & get shoes on.
- 8. When your dancer is done with all his/her performances, you may pick them up. Be sure to have your Parent PICKUP Pass.
- 9. Dancers will need to sit in an open seat in the auditorium (in the upper section) or on your lap. If you want your child in a seat next to you, you will need to purchase that seat ticket.
