

BEFORE Recitals:

1. Which show is your dancer in?
2. Explain to your dancer you may not be in dressing room since you sit with the audience to applaud & watch them be the "STAR" of the show. Let them know you will be back to pick them up after they are done dancing & smiling on stage.
3. Practice hair & make-up.
4. Practice costume changes (if any), putting costumes on & off in show order. Take a calm approach, step by step, taking off & dropping pieces into their dance bag. No underwear, jewelry or nail polish!
5. Practice putting on shoes.
6. Pack "Dancer's Survival Kit" (same as rehearsal)
7. Pack a book, toy or games. Label all items.
8. No Juice or Markers please!

DURING Recitals:

1. Dancer and Parent Pass holder use door #20. All others enter through main foyer.
2. Take your dancer to the bathroom!
3. Bring dance bag with dancer's name on it.
4. Check in at designated table with your dancer.
5. Come dressed in 1st costume with hair & makeup done. No underwear, jewelry or nail polish.
6. Wear cover-ups over costume while traveling. Carry shoes.
7. No Juice or Food ! Spills & messes make costumes icky!
8. We have experienced helpers in dressing rooms. Please let them know if you will or will not be coming to help with your dancer with costume changes.
9. When your dancer is done with all her performances, you may pick them up. Be sure to have your Parent Pass.
10. Dancers will need to sit in an open seat or on your lap.
